## Computational Phylogenetic Methods and Austronesian Subgrouping

In this talk we will outline the power and potential pitfalls of applying Bayesian phylogenetic methods to the task of inferring linguistic relationships. We will analyze a large database of basic vocabulary for over 300 Austronesian languages (see <a href="http://language.psy.auckland.ac.nz/">http://language.psy.auckland.ac.nz/</a>). The ability of Bayesian phylogenetic methods to recover accepted Austronesian subgroups and generate novel results will be discussed.
